

Fertilizer Granulation Processes and Micronutrients
November 3-7, 2008 – Bangkok, Thailand

The workshop will cover production methods and equipment; plant and equipment design; storage and handling of granular fertilizers; raw materials and product quality issues; and incorporation of micronutrients in fertilizer products. The program will address DAP, MAP, GTSP, and NPK granulation processes. In addition the training program will address compaction/granulation, bulk blending, and fluid fertilizer processes. Participants will be exposed to a range of topics through classroom presentations, discussions, group work assignments, and field trips to fertilizer granulation production and storage facilities.

The workshop is designed for technical managers and engineers engaged in production and design, storage, and handling of granulated compacted, blended, and fluid fertilizers; quality control, process, and design engineers engaged in engineering, equipment supply, and revamping granular fertilizer plants; entrepreneurs contemplating the establishment of fertilizer granulation production facilities; and policymakers involved in agricultural planning.

The program fee for the 5-day training workshop is \$1,200.
